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Introduction:

Welcome to *Strategies for Improving Reading Comprehension:* K-2, a professional development course geared primarily for educators serving students in grades K-2 (and others). Reading comprehension is the ability to read text, process it, and understand its meaning. An individual's ability to comprehend text is influenced by their traits and skills, one of which is the ability to make inferences. In today's world of academia, students are expected to perform at even higher levels.
